



A guide to using CrimeReports.com





Welcome to CrimeReports.com. On the homepage you'll see the states that have participating agencies shaded in. From here you can select the state of choice or type your address in the field above the map. If you enter your address you'll be taken directly to that location on the map.



If you select a shaded state you'll then see a list of participating agencies in that state.

Choose the agency of interest and you'll be taken to their map showing the most recent reported incidents in the area.

The last 14 days of data are shown on the map by default. Only a few categories of incidents are displayed by default (Homicide, Burglary, Vehicle Burglary, Robbery, Theft, Vehicle Theft, Sex Offenses, and Assaults). You can change the date selection by clicking on the Calendar button located above the map. You can also select more crime categories by clicking on the Crime Types button above the map.



A number of Law Enforcement Agencies have provided CrimeReports.com with local Sex Offender data. If that is the case with your area, you will see a Show Sex Offenders button above the map. Select this and you will see the pin points and information for the local sex offenders. If CrimeReports.com does not have sex offender data for your area this option is not available.
